1 Addendum #3 May - 2022: Valid until recalled by CRT-20 2 This Addendum supersedes Addendum #2 December-2020 3 **Introduction** 4 5 In response to continued COVID-19 safety concerns, the UTPC program moved to temporary 6 Virtual Inspections while government-issued travel restrictions were in place. Travel restrictions 7 have been lifted in the contiguous United States and PTI's Unbonded Tendon Plant 8 Certification program returns to in-person inspections with the following safety precautions in 9 place: 10 Inspectors and in-person plant personnel directly active in the inspection shall take the following 11 measures: 12 Sign waiver, fill in health survey, take temperature at beginning of the inspection 13 (Attachment A). 14 • Wear properly fitting masks 15 • Practice social distancing (6 ft or more where available) 16 Upon request by a plant (PTI will survey plants to determine if this is requested), a negative self-17 administered rapid COVID test result will be provided by the inspector from morning of the 18 inspection. If the plant is requesting testing, they must also be willing to provide a negative 19 20 rapid COVID test result for any employee in direct contact with the inspector, at the plant's expense upon request of the inspector. 21 For plants located in regions with CDC issued Level 4 travel alerts or where government-issued 22 travel restrictions remain in place, PTI's Unbonded Tendon Plant Certification inspections will 23 be conducted virtually via GoToMeeting. 24 25 It is essential that plants notify PTI in case they are closed or not producing. **Virtual Inspections: Personnel and Internet Requirements** 26 27 28 The inspector must be able to review the documentation and the physical plant on the GoToMeeting. As the plant sees appropriate, one or more individuals may facilitate the 29 inspection (for example, the office manager provides all access to paper and / or electronic 30 documentation from the plant office or from home and the plant manager provides access 31 through a phone camera to plant information such as the coil tags and other items stored in the 32 plant). 33 Plants to provide a contact for a management-level person who could be contacted in addition to 34 the primary plant contact. 35

PTI will provide instruction on how to prepare devices for the GoToMeeting and how to log in.
