- Please include a mix of construction and completed project photos
- By uploading photos into this platform, the submitter gives the Post-Tensioning Institute a no-fee and royalty-free license to reproduce and publish all submitted images and text in any and all materials, printed and electronic, necessary for the editorial and promotional dissemination of the 2021 PTI Project Awards.
