# 2019 PTI AWARDS

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# CALL FOR ENTRIES

## Eligibility:

Any structure that uses post-tensioning as a structural component, was constructed or rehabilitated in the past 7 years, and was not entered into the 2017 PTI Project Awards is eligible. Entries may be submitted by the owner, architect, engineer, contractor, or post-tensioning supplier.

## Categories:

Awards will be presented in each of the six following categories:

- Buildings
- Bridges
- Parking Structures
- Slab-on-Ground
- Industrial/Special Applications
- Repair, Rehabilitation, and Strengthening

## Judging:

Winners will be selected by a jury of distinguished industry professionals. Entries will be judged based on creativity, innovation, ingenuity, cost-effectiveness, functionality, constructibility, and aesthetics.

## Awards:

Awards will be given in each category and will be presented at the PTI Awards Dinner on Monday, May 6, 2019, during the 2019 PTI Convention in Seattle, WA. Each award recipient will receive a commemorative plaque and will be recognized in the awards brochure. Additionally, program winners will be featured in a *PTI JOURNAL* article, in the PTI e-News, on PTI's website, and in a press release issued to PTI's major national trade publications.

## Submittals:

Please include the following with your entry:

1. Entry Form and payment.
2. Dropbox link **OR** flash drive that contains the following:
  - Entry Form—Fill out the entry form identifying the appropriate contributing parties (owner, architect, engineer, contractor, PT supplier, etc.). **Note: This form should be the ONLY PLACE in the entry submittal where your name and firm name are stated.**

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- Project Detail Form—Fill out a short description of project details, use of post-tensioning, cost data, construction sequence, and timeline.
  - Please remember to include the full description of the project as a separate document. There is no word limit to this description. Remember, the judges are grading your project based on creativity, innovation, ingenuity, cost-effectiveness, functionality, constructibility, and aesthetics
- **Project Photographs**—Submit **at least five and no more than 25 electronic images** of the project, per the following requirements (**note: submittals that do not meet the following photo requirements will be disqualified**):
  - If possible, submit a mix of both vertical and horizontal orientations of both construction and completed projects.
  - **ALL** photos submitted should be **high-resolution raw, TIFF, EPS, or JPG format**.
  - **Files must be 300 dpi or greater and at least 8.5 x 11 inches in size**.
  - Videos (optional) – Include any videos related to the project using a format compatible with Windows Media Player. Provide actual video files as opposed to URLs.
- Optional—Entries may also include drawings, sketches, calculations, and specifications necessary to demonstrate the design and construction aspects of the structure.

### Entry Fee:

The entry fee helps cover the cost of awards and associated publicity and promotion of the winners.
